- B) Primary swimming lessons are no longer approved by the board for safety reasons so will have to be discontinued at this time. The board does still support the Swim to Survive program for grade 4 students so we will continue with that program. We will look at other opportunities for community involvement for all grades, perhaps at Walford Manor.
- C) Our enrollment is sitting at 218, which includes 41 students in the JK/SK class.
- D) Our Tim Hortons Camp application has been approved. Grades 6-8 will have the opportunity to attend two leadership focused camping trips to Parry Sound. In between the two trips, they will take part in a project that will work to improve their community and create a positive change. Emphasis will be put on teambuilding, a values contract, goal setting, creating an action plan and problem solving. Activities will include journaling, scrapbooking and campfire among other outdoor activities. Meals will be provided as well as transportation on a coach bus.
