Is your child starting school this fall? Copper Cliff Public School will host its information night for Kindergarten registrations. All parents/guardians and children are invited to attend. When registering your child, please bring his/her identification documents including birth certificate, birth registry/baptismal certificate, proof of residency, Ontario Health Card and immunization record.
